


**Dr. Suzanne Steinbaum**

**WHILE THE ROAD 2 RECOVERY** team may change slightly per episode, patient advocate, Dr. Suzanne Steinbaum, will appear throughout the series. Dr. Suzanne, is a former dancer who ultimately became a doctor, following in the footsteps of more than 20 of her relatives. While Dr. Suzanne is a preeminent cardiologist and the director of Women's Heart Health at Lenox Hill Hospital in New York City, her primary focus is to help those suffering from any illness to become aware of the most effective healing resources available to them. In fact, her speaking, writing and advocacy has positively impacted tens of thousands of patients.

**The format for each program** focuses one to two patients who will meet with Dr. Suzanne to discuss their health crisis through a brief, heartfelt Q&A. The R2R team (between 3-4 specialists) hand picked by Dr.

Suzanne for each specific case, are then introduced. The patient meets with each team member individually to identify and understand the different approaches and opinions regarding the illness and methods for healing. These are both emotional and informative consultations that are geared to further empower the patient towards a rewarding and motivated recovery. After the consultations, and potentially speaking with family and or friends, the patient rejoins Dr. Suzanne to make his or her FINAL decision, a BIG reveal that defines a specific treatment path based on the consultations. While Dr. Suzanne will have her opinion, the final decision is in the hands of the patient.
